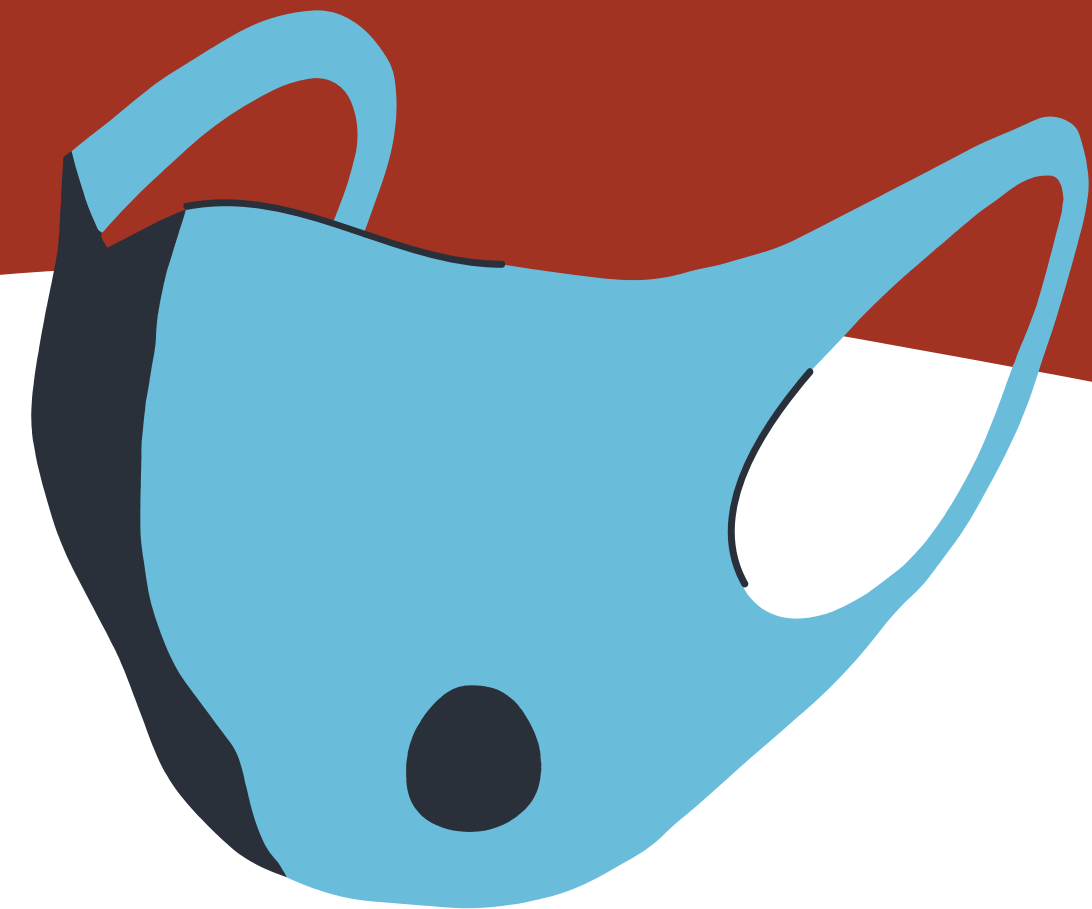




**As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to slow in Canada, Fifth Story has developed a series of policies and procedures to ensure the well being of our clients, staff and vendors so we can safely get back to shooting!**

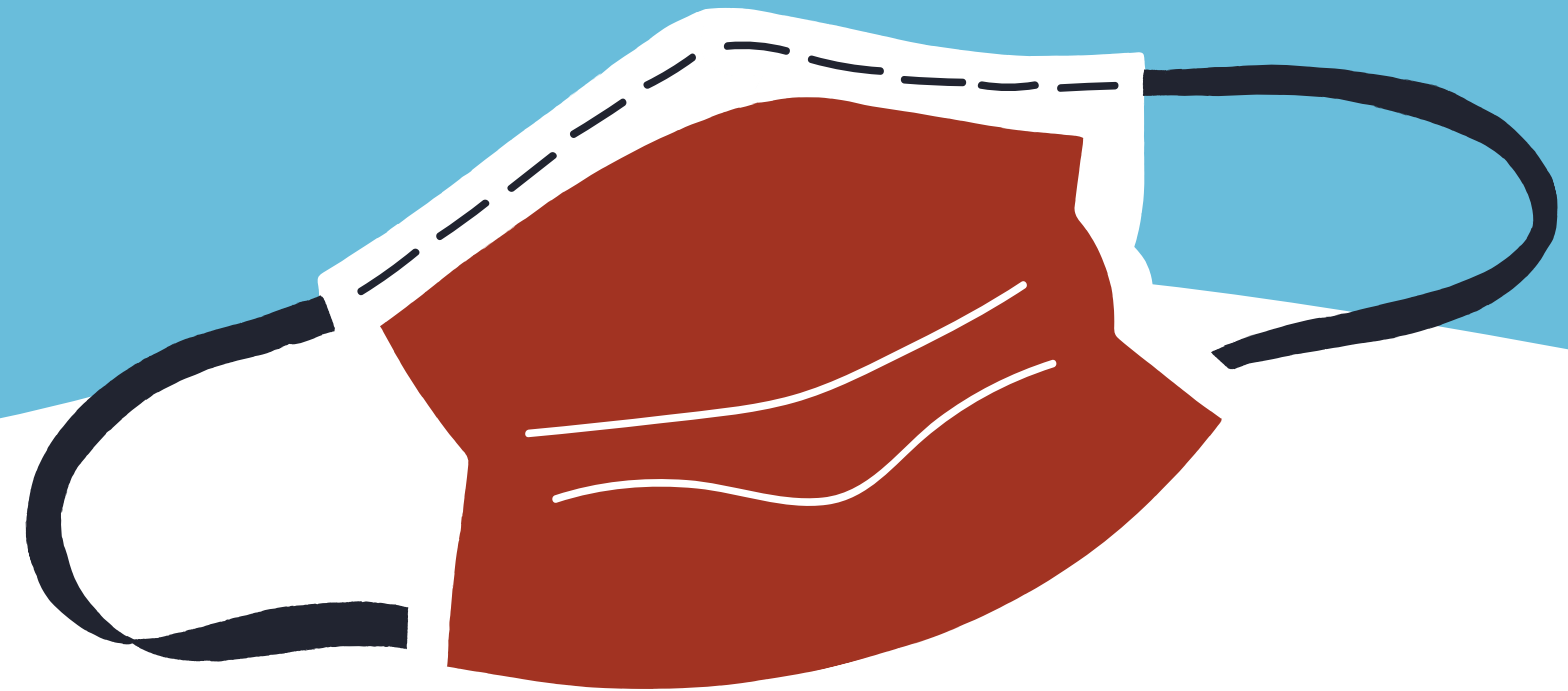
# Planning a shoot – what's new?

- ✓ **New release forms** that ensure all parties involved understand the risks associated with COVID-19 and being on set.
- ✓ **Providing PPE** to everyone on set, including: face masks, face shields, hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes.
- ✓ **Individually wrapped lunch boxes** instead of family-style craft set-ups, along with other safety measures surrounding food/craft.
- ✓ **Hiring an extra crew member** to act as a "floater," in the event someone needs to be sent home (if they display symptoms) to prevent the shoot from being cancelled/postponed.



# What else?

- ✓ **Screening measures** including a questionnaire to be filled out (within 24 hrs prior to the shoot) by all attending the set, as well as temperature checks using a contactless, infrared thermometer on the day.
- ✓ **Hiring a professional cleaner for the day** (TBD on a shoot-by-shoot basis) to keep surfaces clean and germ free.
- ✓ **Signage will be displayed on set** to remind everyone to wear a mask and remain 2 meters apart at all times.
- ✓ **Following government guidelines** for social gathering limits.
